




Great Inventions - Transport

Transport	Type of vehicle.	The Wright brothers invented the world's first controlled aeroplane in 1899.	
Inventor	Somebody who comes up with something new.	In 1903, the Wright brothers built their first powered aircraft. It was called the Flyer.	
Flight	Flying	Before 1903 people could travel in the air by hot air balloon but these were hard to control.	
Journey	Travelling from one place to another.	In 1829, a competition was held (at Rainhill) to find an engine for the first passenger railway.	
Propeller	Blades at the front of a plane.	This competition was called the Rainhill Trials.	
 Propeller		George Stephenson's train, called the Rocket, was the winner.	
Pilot	Person who drives a plane.		
Travel	Go from one place to another.	Wright brothers - the Flyer	
Locomotive	An engine for pulling a train.	The Rainhill Trials
