#### Eligibility for Free School Meals

If your financial circumstances have changed recently, your child may be eligible for Free School Meals or Early Years Pupil Premium.

If eligible you are able to download a certificate to provide to us to support your application for Free School Meals. Please also inform us if you are a military services family or if your child has been adopted as the school receive funding to support pastoral care. Again

this information is in the strictest confidence and Miss Shevlin will be happy to speak to you in private.

#### Secondary School Applications

If you have not already done so, the closing date for applications is Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019.

To give your child the best possible chance of being offered their preferred school(s), please ensure your application is received on time. Hillingdon council cannot be held responsible for any problems with internet providers; they are therefore recommending you submit your application online to the Admissions at London Borough of Hillingdon by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October.

#### Starting Primary School in September 2020

If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2016, please make sure to apply at your local Borough's website and complete St Mary's application form and bring originals of birth certificate, baptism and Certificate of Catholic Practice and proofs of address of child and parent on a Tuesday to the school office by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

# Home-Start Hillingdon needs volunteers to visit struggling families in Hillingdon
