- Employee Volunteering – Your employer releases you to volunteer for a charity or community group to add value to your development and that of the organisation you spend time with. You could volunteer your time supporting a PTA event.
- Match Funding – Your employer matches the sponsorship/funding you have raised to donate to the charity or organisation. You could get the funds raised at a PTA event match funded by your employer.
- Donating Goods or Discounted Vouchers – Your employer donates goods or a voucher for the charity/organisation to use in a Raffle or as a competition prize for one of our events.
