Migration			Walter Raleigh was an explorer born in 1552 (or possibly 1554, historians are not certain).
Refugee			The Titanic was a luxury steamboat that sank in 1912 after striking an iceberg. Many of the passengers lost their lives.
Settler			123 passengers boarded the Titanic at Cobh, Ireland (the majority of them in 3 rd class). Many of these Irish passengers were travelling to America to migrate.
Explorer			'Kindertransport' means 'children's transport'.
Voyage			It was a rescue operation to save Jewish children from the Nazis (ahead of WW2) by bringing them to the UK.
Kindertransport			The Empire Windrush: A ship that carried hundreds of settlers from Jamaica to the UK.
Prejudice			Refugees today are fleeing conflict or persecution.
