Morning Drop-off

Parents can access the school through the Rockingham Close entrance and then walk through the KS1 playground to leave through the green gate on Rockingham Road.

Welcome back! Thank you to the parents who came along to our All Saints Mass on Wednesday. Father Nicholas talked to the children about this special day and suggested they research some saints including-The Ulma family: Killed for having hidden eight Jews in their home in 1944. The Ulma family were beatified this year, making it the first time an entire family were beatified together, including the child carried in the mother's womb at the time of her death.
