# **Morning Drop-off**

All pupils (from Reception to Year 6) come into school from 8.40 a.m. via our Rockingham Road entrance. This gate will be locked at 8.45am). Pupils arriving at the main entrance (after this time) will be marked in the register as late.

#### **Collection Times**

All classes (Reception to Year 6) finish school at 3.15pm.

Please use our 1-way system to avoid congestion in our narrow alleyway into school:

Parents can access the school through the Rockingham Close entrance and then walk through the KS1 playground to leave through the green gate on Rockingham Road.

Although each class is timetabled for set days for PE lessons, this often changes due to wet weather and extra sports coaching sessions.
All pupils (Years 1 to 6) should bring their P.E kits into school every Monday and then take them home every Friday. Thank you for your help.

To give your child the best possible chance of being offered their preferred school(s), please ensure your application is received on time. Hillingdon council cannot be held responsible for any problems with internet providers; they are therefore recommending you submit your application online to the Admissions at London Borough of Hillingdon by Friday 20th October 2023. If you live out of borough you need to apply to your own local authority.

# Eligibility for Household Benefits
